- 1. Applicant must be a Sooper Credit Union member in good standing. (Account may not be dormant.)**
- 2. Application must be signed and complete. Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
- 3. Print in ink, or type your application.**
- 4. Include the following documentation with your application:**
  - A. Most current transcript (sealed). (i.e.: High school or college)**
  - B. Copy of official report of your S.A.T. and/or A.C.T. Scores, unless these scores are included in official transcript.**
  - C. Two letters of recommendation from non-family members.**
  - D. A one or two page resume; this should include your extracurricular school activities, leadership positions, awards or honors and your involvement in community activities.**
